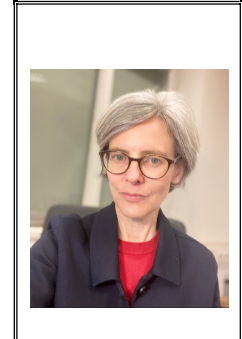

Jo Goodey (PhD) has been a Head of Unit at FRA, responsible for different strands of the Agency's research, since 2009. Prior to this, in the 1990s she held full lectureships in criminology and criminal justice at the Universities of Sheffield and Leeds in the UK, and was subsequently a research fellow for two years at the UN Office on Drugs and Crime. She has been a study fellow at the Max Planck Institute for the Study of Crime, Security and Law in Freiburg. Since working for the EU she has, among other activities, chaired the EU Agencies' Network on Scientific Advice and was a member of the EU's High-Level Expert Group on Artificial Intelligence. She is the author of an academic textbook on victims of crime and has published numerous academic journal articles and book chapters on various subjects including human trafficking, crime victims, violence against women, and research methodologies.
